

Method of Installing Windows Media Player and Adobe Flash Player

You must have Windows Media® Player 11 or later, or Adobe® Flash® Player 10 or later installed to insert and play back video.

Windows Media® Player : wmv, avi and the mpeg format, etc. can be played.

Adobe® Flash® Player : swf format can be played.

1. Method of checking the version of Windows Media Player installed

Open “Windows Media Player” from the Start menu.

([Start] - [All Programs] - [Accessories] - [Entertainment] - [About Windows Media Player])

Select menu [Help] – [About Windows Media Player] on Windows Media Player.

*If “Windows Media Player” menu does not exist, Windows Media Player has not been installed.

2.1. Windows Media Player

If the following link is clicked, it jumps to Microsoft Site (United States).

Change language as needed and download the software.

Logon as the user of administrator authority and install it.

2.2. Adobe Flash Player

If the following URL is clicked, it jumps to Adobe Site.
