This name has phone number in all number fields.

<Tab>David Jones<Tab><Tab>502<Tab>652<Tab><Tab><Tab>4445555<Tab><CR><LF>

This name has phone number in 1st and 2nd and 5th number field.

<Tab>Ellen Parker<Tab><Tab>503<Tab><Tab><Tab><Tab><CR><LF>

This name has phone number in 1st number field.

<Tab>Frank Powel<Tab><Tab><Tab><Tab><Tab><Tab>504<Tab><CR><LF>

This name has phone number in 5th number field.

Note.

- <BOM>: Byte Order Mark for little endian (0xFEFF)
- <Tab>: 0x0009
- <CR>: 0x000D
- <LF>: 0x000A

The line break of above samples is <CR><LF>.

- Please note that one PS can hold up to 500 phone numbers.
  - ex. One number per name -> up to 500 names
  - 5 numbers per name -> up to 100 names
